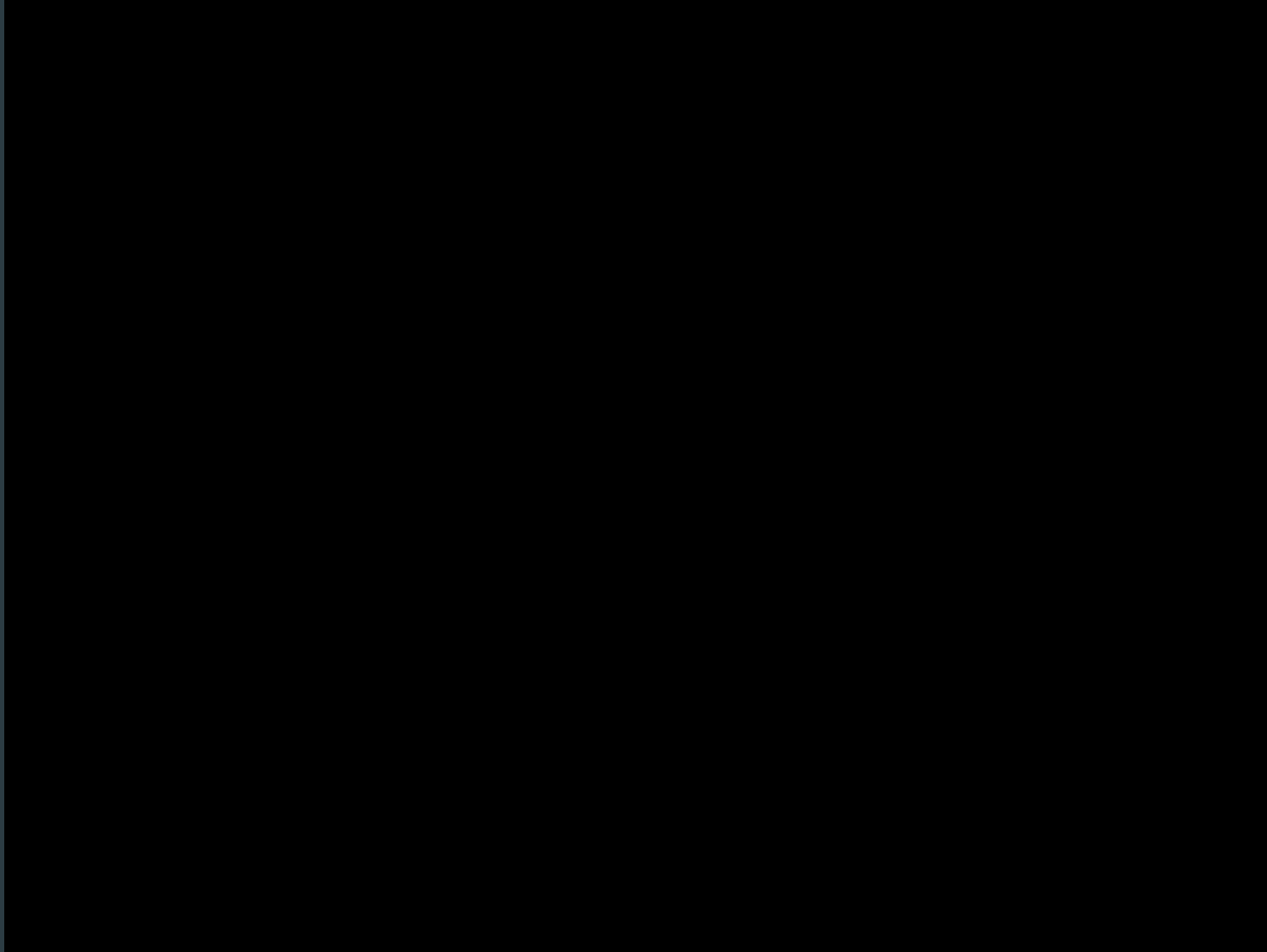

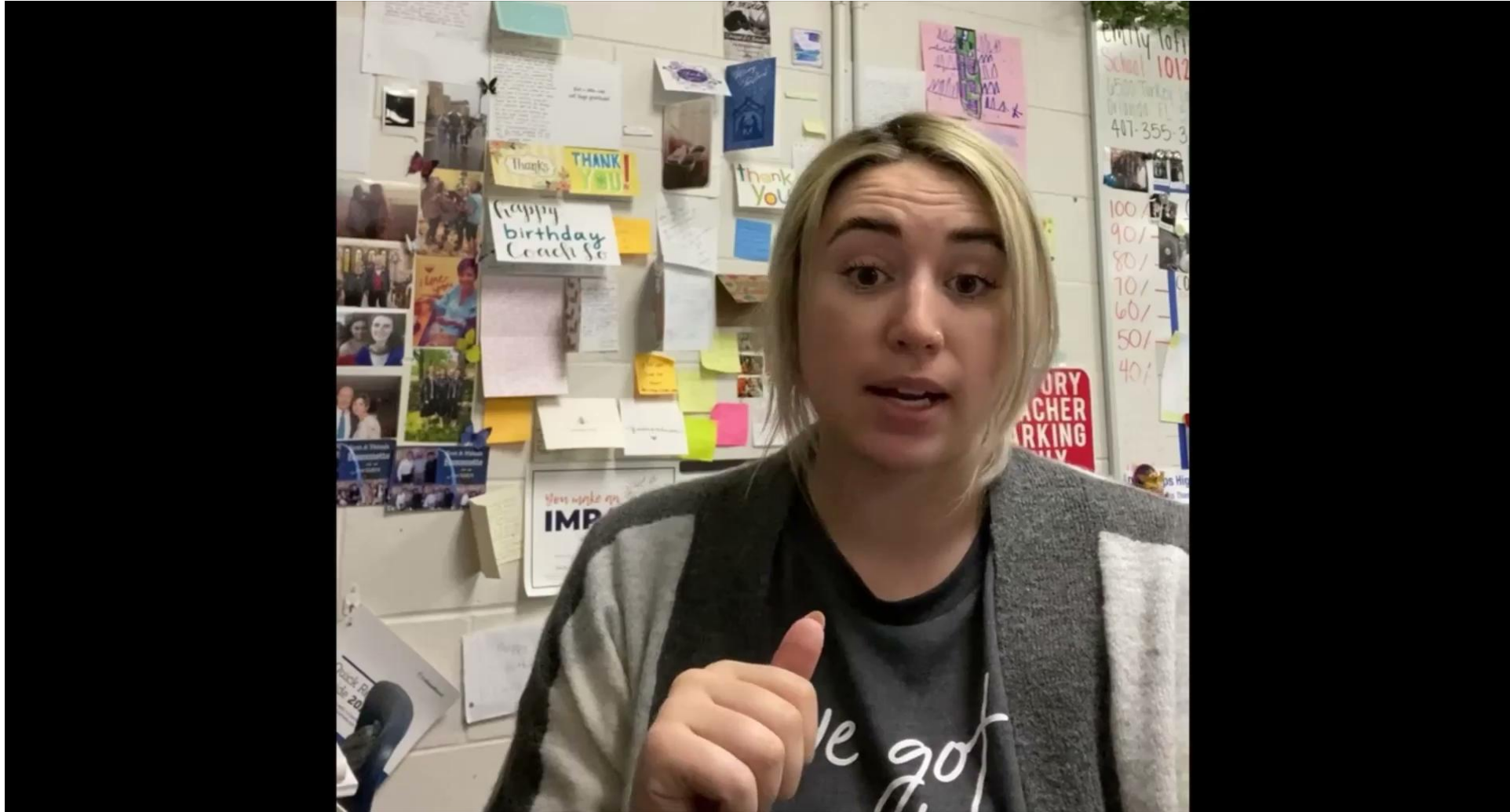

## Contract for AP Course Enrollment

The primary purpose of this document is to ensure that you are fully aware of the academic rigor, requirements, and expectations which are part of the AP course(s) in which you wish to enroll.

#### Dear Student:

You are registered to take one or more AP course(s) during the 2020-2021 school year.

It is essential that you understand that this is a rigorous college-level course, equivalent to a course taken during the first year of college, and by taking an AP course you have the potential to earn college credit. The level of intellectual maturity, ability, organizational skills, and intrinsic motivation required for success in an AP course is therefore considerable. There may be intensive homework load; you will be expected to complete frequent assignments, readings and projects outside of class, which may have implications on your time and commitments to other endeavors such as extracurricular activities.

It is required that if you are enrolled in an AP course, you will take the appropriate College Board examination in May, 2021. Taking an AP course and exam is a collaborative effort between the student, parent/guardian, the teacher, and the school. Each party plays an essential role and must make a sincere commitment to meet the demands of that role to ensure success in an AP course. Consequently, it is essential that the student enrolls in an AP course for the correct reasons and understands the full scope of the expectations which will be placed on him/her as part of the academic realities and requirements of each AP course.

You agree to organize your time and effort successfully to complete each AP course in you are enrolled; complete all assignments on time; maintain regular attendance; arrive to class on time, with the correct materials, texts and assignments, ready to learn; notify your teacher and parent/guardian immediately if you fall behind in class assignments and ask for extra help, as required; and take the AP examination for this course in May, 2021.

Once enrolled in an AP course it is expected that students complete the course. If however a student is not successful in the AP course they may request to be removed by contacting their guidance counselor to begin the steps listed below.

- 1) Student completes a Request to Drop a Rigorous Course Form
- 2) Student indicates if they have completed all assignments, however they still have a D or F in the course.
- 3) Student attends tutoring in the AP course requesting to be removed from
- 4) A conference must take place with the student, parent/guardian, AP teacher, and guidance counselor
- 5) The guidance counselor will then submit the request form to be reviewed by administration.

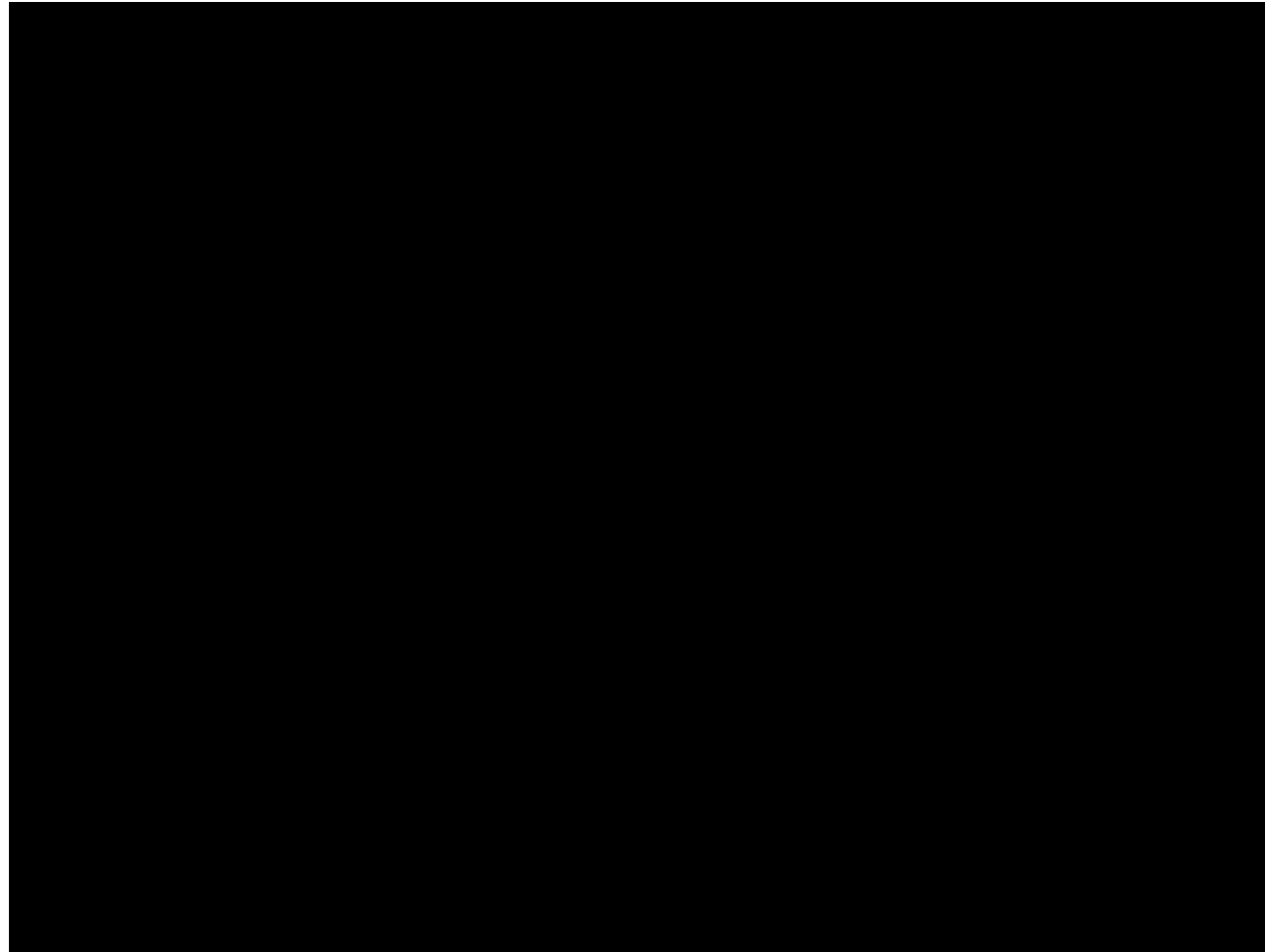

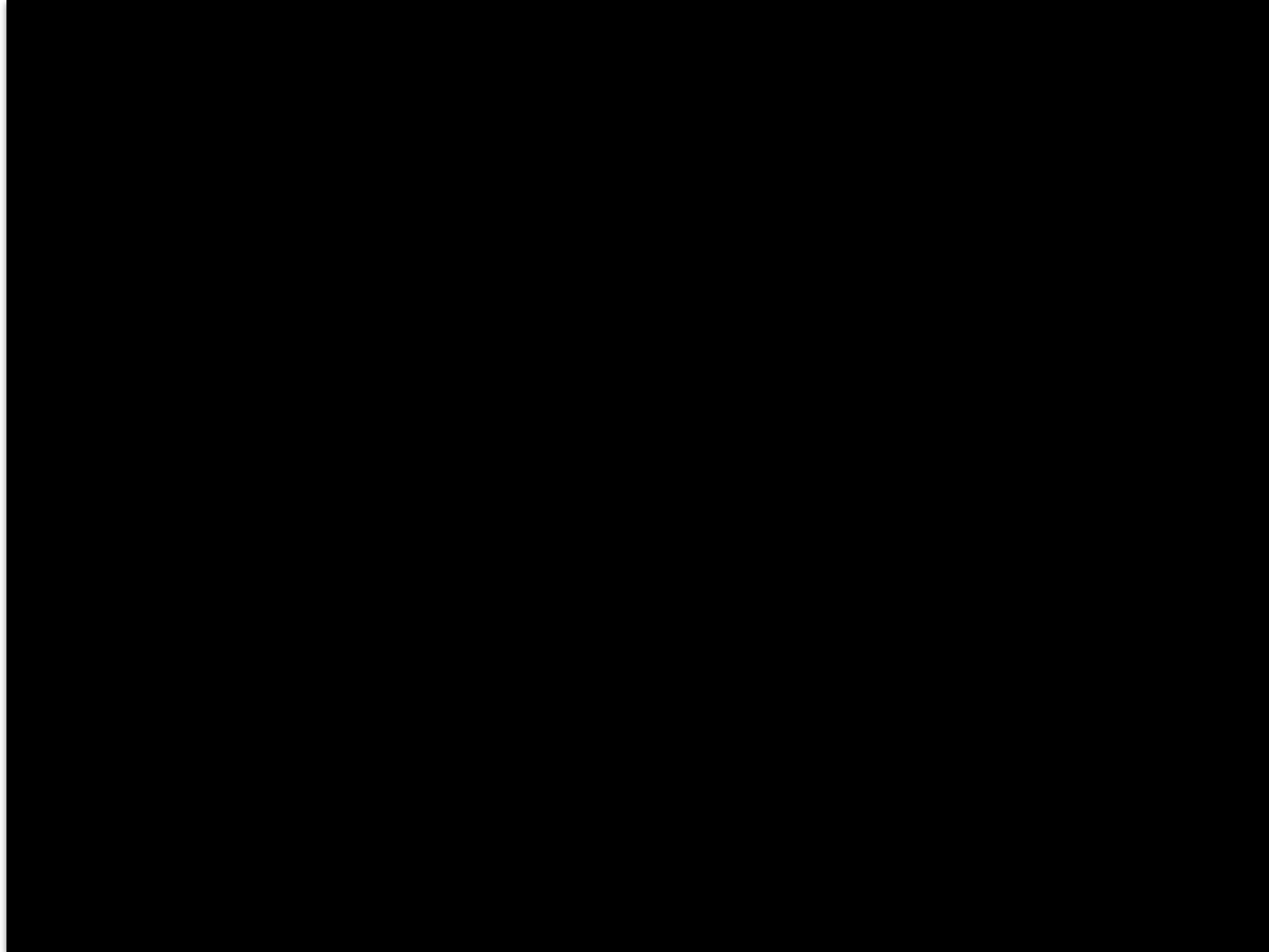
